- Include a visual representation of significant assets for the organization.
- Include a document that explains how these mapped assets would be beneficial within the context of BHRR.

Asset Mapping Tools

Various mapping programs are accessible online. Please note that this list does not cover all available resources online:

- <u>Map My Community</u>: This is a mapping tool that can locate resources in your area that are sorted by topics or department. The department of labor is one of the resources found in this mapping tool.
- <u>My Neighborhood Data</u>: My Neighborhood Data is a mapping tool specific to the Los Angeles area and can be sorted by neighborhood, cities, or census tracks.
- <u>Google Maps</u>: This mapping tool allows an organization to input their own resources or search for resources using the search options available. It also allows you to layer resources on maps that you create.
