What is the mentored internship program (MIP)?

Due to the growing number of people needing behavioral health services during the pandemic, the Department of Healthcare Services and Advocates of Human Potential, Inc. are working with SCHC in putting together a paid internship program for students like you who may be interested in working in behavioral health services.

The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is expanding California's behavioral health workforce as well as other behavioral health professions, to improve consumer access to and productive participation in behavioral health services throughout the state.

Who can apply for the MIP?

This opportunity is for students 18 and older, and at multiple stages of their education, to gain practical on-the-job experience as paid interns in nonprofit organizations and county-operated provider settings providing health services.
