Identify potential risks early


Identify the Scope, Brainstorm

> Plan approach in dealing with risk

Participatory Process involving key partners

Identify Goals and Objectives

> Identify context of the risk management effort

Determine optimal outcomes


Management or Reduction?

Explore and document efficiency of risk responses

> Keep records of actions taken

Communicate the results of any risk mitigation to key partners

> Clear, concise, transparent
